



Paul McAuley Appointed CEO of 3SO

Allan Katz, Chair of the Board of Directors of Shared Support Services Southeastern Ontario (3SO) announced today the appointment of Paul McAuley to the position of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) effective August 27, 2018. The Agreement was finalized on June 8, 2018. Mr. McAuley brings more than two decades of progressively responsible leadership experience to the role and is currently the Senior Director of Strategic Planning and Governance at Quinte Health Care.

"I am tremendously excited and look forward to getting to know the people who've made 3SO such a highly respected shared service organization," said McAuley, who has Bachelor and Master's Degrees in Applied Science from the University of Waterloo as well as a Master's Degree in Business Administration from McMaster University. He also completed the Advanced Health Leadership Program at the Rotman School of Management at the University of Toronto.

"I am eager to get started, building on the success of 3SO. I am looking forward to working alongside everyone at our Kingston office and with all our key stakeholders at our six hospital member sites across region," he added.

Most recently, Mr. McAuley has supported Quinte Health Care in the development and implementation of their strategic plan. This has included implementing a formal improvement approach based on the Toyota Management system and adopting the LEADS Leadership Development framework. Prior to this role, he was involved in eHealth, serving as the Regional Chief Information Officer for the South East Local Health Integration Network and the Health Care Network of Southeastern Ontario and Director of Information Management at the former Kingston General Hospital.

Mr. McAuley lives near Odessa with his wife, a Chemical Engineering Professor at Queen's University. His two daughters also have ties to Queen's – his oldest is an Engineering Alumni who works as a process improvement consultant in Calgary and his youngest is starting Medical School in the fall.

"His experience and enthusiasm were clearly evident throughout the recruitment process," said Mr. Katz. "We're delighted to welcome someone of his caliber to lead 3SO in service to our member hospitals across the region. I also wish to take the opportunity to thank Mr. Bill Hunter and Mr. Barry Blaskie who served as interim co-chief executives. Together, they provided exceptional leadership to the organization and to the region's supply chain enterprise."
